Report of the IUSSP Elections Committee

The 2009 IUSSP Council Elections were conducted via the Internet and all votes cast were automatically tabulated by eBallot, the online voting company hired to conduct the online balloting, making it unnecessary to hold a meeting of the full Election Committee in Paris to supervise counting the ballots. Only 31 postal ballots were received by the Secretariat.

One member of the Elections Committee, Thérèse Locoh, came to the IUSSP Secretariat on Monday 12 October to supervise the counting of the 31 postal ballots that were received by mail or handed to the Secretariat during the Marrakech Conference.

Of the 31 postal ballots received, 27 were valid; 2 ballots were voided because the individuals had voted online, 1 ballot was submitted by a non-IUSSP member, and 1 ballot was submitted by an IUSSP member who had joined after 1 July 2009 and was thus not eligible to participate in this election. The postal ballots were counted by Thérèse Locoh and tabulated by Mary Ellen Zuppan and Paul Monet.

The results of the online balloting have been viewed and approved by all members of the Elections Committee and the mail-in ballots have been added to the Internet ballot results.

Please find attached the election results. A total of 1144 IUSSP members voted—the largest number yet and the largest percentage (49.2%) of IUSSP members to participate in an IUSSP election.

We, the undersigned, John Casterline, Thérèse Locoh, and Huda Zurayk, have been fully informed about the whole electoral procedure and we approve the procedure. Having counted the votes we declare the following results:
